**Abstract:**

The purpose of this session is to provide opportunities with researchers from various fields to share recent trends of the study of language in industry-academia collaboration. Recent trends are that linguistics and its application fields have been becoming more and more inter-dependent. Thus, the "Trans-Border" or "Interdisciplinary" perspective is necessary. Specifically, the recent linguistic data for research is "big" and "contextualized". This session especially focuses on the use of Big Data on food culture from both academic and application points of view. The organizer hopes that the session will stimulate the possibility for uncovering future unexplored areas of research of language.
